



# IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR FUTURE AT SJSU

- If you did not pass the ELM and/or the EPT, you will be required to take one or more remedial courses during your first year. These courses will not count toward your degree and may delay your graduation. You will also be restricted to a limited course selection. (See list of courses on other side.)
- **EO 665** is a Chancellor's Office Regulation that affects students who do not pass one or both of the required placement tests. It is very important that you understand how this regulation affects you. The EO665 Handbook is designed to give you all of the information you will need to know about policies on remediation. - **Please read the following information carefully.**
  1. You must be enrolled in and attending required developmental math and English classes during your first semester.
  2. Failure to enroll in or attend a required course will cause you to be dropped from all classes.
  3. You must complete any required remedial courses by the end of your first year.
  4. **If you have not completed the required remediation by the end of your first year, you will not be allowed to enroll for another term at any CSU Campus until these requirements have been met.**
