For Integrative Undergraduate Research and Applications Projects

The SJSU Department of Anthropology supports undergraduate projects, with priority given to projects that integrate skills and knowledge from at least two fields of anthropology: cultural, physical, archaeology, and applied. Awards are made up to \$500. Applications are accepted on December 1 and May 1 of each calendar year. (If these dates fall on a weekend, the deadline is the following Monday). Due to limited resources, the department may be unable to support all requests for support made in any academic year; students should check with a faculty sponsor before preparing a request.

Process:

Applications for support should include the following:

- 1. This page, which should serve as a cover sheet.
- 2. Descriptions of the project that includes the budget, budget rationale, and timeline for the implementing and completing it (maximum of one page single spaced in 10pt type).
- 3. Copy of unofficial transcript of all college work.
- 4. Endorsement of an anthropology faculty sponsor (brief paragraph).
- 5. Signed photo/video release form (available in Clark Hall 469)

Applications should be submitted to the Administrative Coordinator in the Anthropology office (CL 469).

Outcomes

Students who are awarded support must enroll in a 1 unit ANTH 180 or 280 course with their faculty sponsor; will be expected to produce a project deliverable (report, scholarly paper, etc.) that meets professional standards, and will be expected to write a one page summary with photo or graphic for the department and/or College of Social Sciences blog.
