

## Associated Students, SJSU, Board of Directors' Resolution 22/23-01 RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF "WOMEN, LIFE, FREEDOM"

**Whereas,** It is the mission of Associated Students of San José State University to represent the students of San José State University and continually improve the quality of their educational opportunity and experience; and

**Whereas,** Associated Students (A.S.) is the official voice of over 35,000 students at San José State University (SJSU); and

**Whereas,** The death of Mahsa Zhina Amini, the 22-year-old Kurdish-Iranian woman who was brutally beaten and later died at the hands of Iran's morality police, sparked mobilizations in expression of solidarity by courageous Iranian Women and Girls who raised their voices for human rights and freedom in their rallying cry, "Woman, Life, Freedom"; and

**Whereas,** Amidst the peaceful protest for basic human rights and freedom, lives are unjustly taken and citizens are met with police brutality and violence; and

**Whereas,** There is an estimated 215,000 Iranians living in the state of California, with San José State University being the home for Iranian students, faculty, staff, and alumni; many of which continue to have close ties with friends and family in Iran; and

**Whereas,** The Silicon Valley and San José area is home to the second largest community of Iranian and Iranian Americans in California with one of the largest populations outside of Iran including Iranian International Students and Scholars; and



Resolved. That SJSU Associated Students recognizes and honors the students and teachers throughout Iran's universities and schools, who are under attack and are involved in the movement for human rights; and be it further

Resolved. That SJSU Associated Students stands in opposition and condemns the violence, police brutality, and terror throughout Iran; and be it further

Resolved, That SJSU Associated Students supports the domestic and overseas Iranian students and women, and the movement for "Women, Life, Freedom"; and be it finally
