Undergraduate and Graduate Chemistry Majors

The SAACS Chemistry Club Scholarship is funded by the SAACS Club which generated funding by selling lab manuals. To be considered for a scholarship you must have a **declared major in chemistry; have successfully completed Chem. 1A/B;** and **have a minimum 3.0 GPA in Chemistry** (OR demonstrate significant accomplishments in research with a faculty member OR significant service to the chemistry club, if your GPA is below a 3.0).

Awards are made at the start of Fall semester. Recipients must register for at least 12 units in Fall 2017 and bring a copy of their class list to the Department Office after the first day of school for Fall 2017. Once the last day to drop has passed we will request the checks. Awards can range from \$500 to \$2,500.

Due date is Friday, April 7th, 2017 to the Chemistry Department (DH 518) by 3PM.
