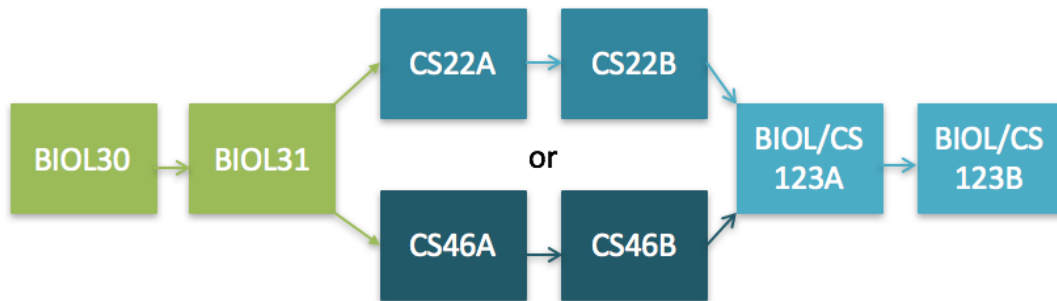


# Fall 2017
