

In-CTRL Scholarships

Scholarship Requirements:

In-CTRL Software seeks to support SJSU students by providing a “real-world” experience working in a start-up. 4 students will get a front row seat to the business development and actively engage in integrating technologies into mobile applications for the lodging industry. You’ll be given project(s) that will require app development and in some cases getting the app to interact with sensors and devices. You will work under one or more In-CTRL persons’ direction and will also be required to interface with the team in India.

Students may apply if they meet the following criteria:

- Must be U.S. citizens
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher with major in Computer Science
- Must have passed CS 160 or equivalent
- 3rd or 4th year Computer Science undergraduate or Graduate students
- Required to sign a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA)
- Proficiency in Java and reasonable level of fluency in Swift and/or Obj C

In-CTRL will pay tuition fees for one year, for four SJSU Computer Science students. In return, those students agree to each work for 12 hours per week for a total of 41 weeks in the year participating in apps development activities with In-CTRL Software.

About the company:

In-CTRL Software is building an integrated platform to simplify the hotel check-in process via self-check-in, keyless hotel room entry and other value-add in-room services for the guests, along with a set of personal assistant apps that will offer greater productivity and travel related information. Overall, the goal is to enhance hotels guests’ experience with the use of this app along with addressing the needs of the hotelier and the Brand (the hotel chain).

In-CTRL is funded by the founder and the first deliverable is a Proof of Concept (POC) which will help secure future funding. The mobile app will be built on both Android and iOS mobile platforms and everything backend will be on Windows servers.
