## KEEPING IT SIMPLE: HOW TO START AND TEACH AN AP/HONORS ECONOMICS COURSE

The Center for Economic Education at San Jose State University is pleased to offer a workshop series on teaching AP/Honors Economics. This series of 4 workshops is designed and delivered by two high school instructors with over 20 years experience teaching AP economics courses. Participants receive practical advice, lesson plans, hints, road maps to student pitfalls, and support. SJSU faculty noted for their excellence in teaching will also provide guest presentations.

The workshop series is open to current high school instructors of economics, math, history, or social sciences, who teach or are interested in starting an AP/Honors course in economics.

Workshops will be held at Cupertino High School (Room 108). Workshops run from 4:00 to 7:30 p.m. Workshops are scheduled for the following Wednesdays: Sept. 28, Oct. 5, Oct. 19, Nov. 2, 2005.

The first workshop provides a calendar for scheduling AP content across the semester. Subsequent workshops focus on teaching key economic concepts. After successfully completing all 4 workshops (12 hours), participants will receive a \$200 stipend. Participants also receive preference in joining the SJSU, Unitrack program for AP/Honors economics courses.
