LYLE V. BURMAHLN MEMORIAL FELLOWSHIPS

These scholarships are awarded to the most outstanding history students, *undergraduate or graduate*. These were endowed by the late Mrs. Lyle V. Burmahln, a prominent Santa Clara County resident.

HAROLD AND VELMA BARNES FELLOWSHIP

Endowed by emeritus faculty member, Billie Jensen, in honor of her parents, two fellowships will go to deserving history students, either *undergraduate or graduate*. A 3.5 GPA in the major is not required if there are extenuating circumstances such as workload or family responsibilities.

THE FRIENDS OF STACY TRENARY- BEDDESON BOOK SCHOLARSHIP

Endowed by friends, faculty, and family in honor of Stacy Trenary- Beddeson, SJSU BA/MA (1973-2007). Recipients are *undergraduate/graduate* nominated by SJSU History Department faculty and based on a student's scholarship in the field of Women's History.

SCHOLARSHIPS – UNDERGRADUATES AND GRADUATES

THE BARBARA BUSS CASAROLI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Endowed by the family of the late Barbara Buss Casaroli, a former SJSU student. The award is open to an *undergraduate or graduate student* in Asian history.

THE DONALD "SCOTTY" FLETCHER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Endowed by Sylvan Rosenzweig of the San Jose Tallow Works in honor of his long-time employee. Open to *undergraduate or graduate students* in British History, with a preference for students of Scotland.

THE B. PAUL FLOOD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Endowed by the family of the late B. Paul Flood, a History Department graduate. Open to *undergraduate or graduate students* with strong records of academic achievement in any field of history.

THE BRUCE GELSINGER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is designated for *undergraduate or graduate students*, in the field of European History, with particular consideration to Medieval history or Scandinavian Studies, including Iceland.

THE LEONARD J. HALL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Endowed by the relatives and friends of the late Leonard J. Hall, former SJSU student who gave his life during military service in Vietnam. Applicants should be *seniors or graduate students* who have specialized in modern European history.

THE JAMES H. HIGH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Endowed by the Department of History in memory of the late James H. High, professor of History. Applicants should be *undergraduate or graduate students* in the field of American History.

THE E.P. PANAGOPOULOS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Endowed by the family of the late E.P. Panagopoulos, professor of History. Open to students in ancient history, with a preference for *undergraduate majors*.

THE EDITH SMITH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Endowed by Mrs. Helen Crawford in memory of the late Edith Smith. Open to an *undergraduate student* with an interest in a career in elementary or secondary education.

THE J. J. "TIM" SWEET MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Endowed by the family and friends of the late Tim Sweet, former graduate student at SJSU. Open to *undergraduates* in any field of history.

THE MILDRED GENTRY WINTERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants should be *upper division history majors* of academic achievement and demonstrated need.
