Goal

To promote international educational exchange at San José State University

Purpose

To reward academic excellence, extra -curricular involvement and provide financial assistance to international students

Criteria

1. Applicant must hold F-1 student status
2. Applicant must have maintained legal F-1 status
3. Applicant must have been enrolled at SJSU as a full time student during Spring 2006 and Fall 2006 semesters (no concurrent enrollment*) and Spring 2007 semester - 12 units as an undergraduate student; 9 units as a graduate student
4. Applicant must have at least a 3.75 San José State cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA)
5. Applicant must show documentation of economic need or hardship
6. Applicant's involvement with University and/or local communities will be considered

Application Process

1. Complete the attached application form as well as essay questions.
2. Submit application form, along with necessary documentation to IPS office by **April 2, 2007.**

Selection Process

A reviewing committee will determine the number of units granted for selected applicant. If granted, applicant will receive a refund of Spring 2007 non-resident fees for the number of units waived (i.e.: 3 units is equal to \$1,017.00).

* All credits (units) must have been taken at SJSU
