

ASSIGNMENT 4 / ISD Blueprint (Planning Grid) (Objectives, Instructional Strategies, Assessment)

Use the MS Word file for the attached ISD Planning Grid (download from course web site) to write your instructional objectives, and show the corresponding instructional strategies, and assessment items. Include the performance-content matrix descriptor for each objective.

1. Write the instructional goal at the top of the grid. This is the criterion from your problem statement verbatim.
2. Transfer the tasks from task analysis (Assignment 3) into the grid.
3. Write the objectives in Mager-style format (condition, criteria, performance). For help writing objectives, see the Mager text and Morrison (2007), Chapter 5 (*all of it*) and the examples in Appendix A.]
4. Complete the Performance-content matrix cell reference.
5. Describe the instructional strategy in concise, but descriptive terms. Include all three parts: initial presentation strategy, generative learning strategy, and assessment items.

The ISD Planning Grid is formatted to print on legal size paper (14-inches long). To print on letter size, use your print setup or print dialog box features in MS Word to scale the page.
