

Assignment: ISD Final Project Presentation

Summarizing and presenting your ISD final project for peer review

Instructional goals:

1. summarize a multi-stage, multi-part ISD project for peer review
2. present the summary information using professional presentation techniques in a PowerPoint format (any presentation software is acceptable)
3. evaluate peer presentations using an instructor provided evaluation rubric

Presentation requirements:

1. **5 minutes** in length, no more [your time will be monitored]
2. a **handout** of the presentation slides and/or a supporting document (make enough copies for your classmates)
3. Build your presentation around these five topics:
 - i. Set the **context** for your audience
 - ii. State the **problem**
 - iii. Describe the key aspects of your **needs assessment/analysis**
 - iv. Describe the **instructional intervention** (solution, product)
 - v. Summarize the **lessons you learned** in the process

Presentation format:

- Microsoft PowerPoint*
- 5 minute, timed-format strictly enforced
- Use a stand-up, direct-delivery method of your computer-based presentation, no questions or interaction are expected, but if time allows be prepared to answer questions from your peers.
- Save your presentation on a CD or USB memory drive to bring to class
- *You may need to consider whether your presentation will show correctly on a different operating system. Cross-platform compatibility issues include typefaces, sound and graphic files that get lost, don't play, or appear corrupted.

Peer review process:

- Each student will present to an audience of their peers (whole class or subgroup).
- Given the rubric on page 2 and copies of a peer evaluation score sheet, each student in the audience will write a peer review of each presentation.
- The presenter should keep and analyze the peer review score sheets for a possible future MA portfolio project related to evaluation. (HINT!)
