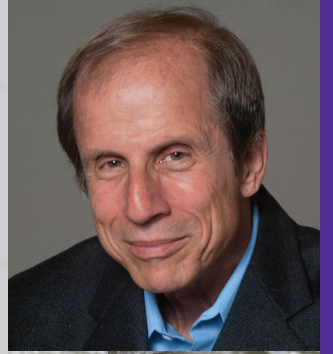
The Sacred Table: Creating a Jewish Food Ethic
