

Faculty Application Procedures

To apply to teach on the Bath, England Program, please submit a proposal that includes the following:

1. **Faculty Application Form** (signed by both your Chairperson and Dean)
(available as a PDF at www.sjsu.edu/depts/studyabroad/; look under Faculty Opportunities Abroad)
2. **A general teaching proposal, which includes a listing of at least four courses that you could teach on the program.** Indicate how you will focus the courses to take advantage of the locale and country. You need to include some courses that fit into the various Advanced General Education categories. You might mention how your courses could be integrated with those being taught by someone from another department, even though you may not know who else might apply. If you know someone from another department who is applying, you might talk with him/her about such a relationship between courses. You might even want to submit a proposal together with someone else.
3. **Any additional information** that you would like to include, such as recent teaching evaluations, a notation of previous foreign teaching or travel experience, an indication of special skills you can offer to the group, or special projects which might be relevant to your assignment in Bath.
4. **An updated vita.**
