

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

International Freshman Admission | Spring 2018

Your admission is “provisional” based on the academic information provided on your official documents. This offer of provisional admission to the academic plan (major) listed on your admission letter is only valid for this term and may not be deferred to another semester. Your admission will remain “provisional” until you have completed all of the mandatory steps below.

Complete the Next Steps Intent to Enroll Process by Wednesday, November 15, 2017.

Complete the following steps in the Intent to Enroll process on the Next Steps website (<https://nextsteps.sjsu.edu/spring>) by **November 15, 2017**.

1. Indicate through the Intent to Enroll link that you accept SJSU’s offer of provisional admission.
2. Sign up for mandatory Frosh Orientation.
3. Pay the non-refundable \$180 Frosh Orientation Fee.
4. **Wait 3-5 business days.** An email confirmation will be sent to you from the nextsteps@sjsu.edu email address. Print and keep this email—it is your Next Steps receipt.

If you do not complete the entire Next Steps Intent to Enroll process by November 15, 2017, we will withdraw your application. Please contact nextsteps@sjsu.edu before the deadline if you have any problems completing these steps.

Complete the I-20 Process

(Transfer from another U.S. institution)

If you live out of the country, you will receive your I-20 with your admission packet. If you are currently attending an educational institution in the U.S., you must download and have your school complete the required “Transfer In Form” at sjsu.edu/isa/forms

Clear Your Medical Insurance Hold

International students must provide proof of approved medical insurance before registering for classes. Insurance holds and purchasing of insurance are handled through the International Student and Scholar Services (ISSS) office. See sjsu.edu/isa for more information.

Reflections on College Writing

Reflections on College Writing is a prerequisite for all students intending to enroll in either English 1A, or English 1AF. Reflections on College Writing allows you to preview the reading and writing you will be required to do in your first writing course and to decide which of the two versions of English 1A you need. You must complete the exercises in Canvas before your orientation date. Check your MySJSU messages in December for information about how to access and complete the Canvas course.
