PAINTS:

- Watercolor in Tubes: Black and White (please check to be sure it is NOT gouache)
- Golden Acrylic in tubes: Black(any) and Titanium White
- 8oz. jar Golden Acrylic Glazing Liquid, gloss (can be shared with two students)
- 5oz. jar Acrylic gel (can be shared with two students)

BRUSHES:

- 1 round sable-type watercolor brush - #3 or 4
- 1 flat sable-type watercolor brush – 1/4" (size 4 or 6)
- 1 bamboo brush - largest size

PAPER:

- Pad of bristol board, smooth, 9x12 inches *
- Pad of tracing paper, 9x12 inches *
- Hardbound Sketch book – 6x9" or similar *
- 2 illustration boards, 15x20" (hot or cold press)
- 1 sheets Rives BFK printmaking paper, 22x30 inches (white or off-white)
- 1 sheet black Drawing Paper (approximately 18x24" or larger) *

DRAWING TOOLS:

- 1 Speedball pen holder, and nib #513EF
- 1 bottle India ink
- Pencils: H, 2B, 4B
- 1 brass or aluminum sharpener
- 1 black shapie or technical pen
- 1 gum eraser
