PAPER:

- Newsprint pad 18x24" +
- Drawing pad 18x24" of high quality white paper
- Pad of Bristol Board - Vellum 11x14"
- Pad of tracing paper 19x24"
- 1 sheet illustration board, 15x20" +
- 1 sheet gray charcoal paper 18x24" (approximate)

DRAWING JOURNAL:

- Hard Cover Sketch book 9x12" or similar size

CHARCOAL:

- Vine charcoal, soft (several pieces) +
- Compressed charcoal, extra soft +
- Charcoal pencil, soft
- Conte crayons – white, brown, and sepia
- Soft pastels (not oil pastels) – white, gray, yellow, red, blue
- Chamois

GRAPHITE:

- Pencils: 2H, H, 2B(several), 4B, 6B, 8B +
- 1 graphite stick 4B +
- 1 brass or aluminum sharpener +

ERASERS:

- Kneaded eraser + plastic eraser +

INKS & PENS & BRUSHES:

- Speedball (or similar) Pen holder and nibs (I recommend #513EF)
- 1 bottle India ink
- Bamboo brush (large) #6
- 1 black sharpie (a variety of marking pens - whatever you already have on hand)
- Writing pens (rollerball type)

OTHER MATERIALS:

- Drawing Board 23x26" and clips +
- 1 roll drafting tape +
- #11 Exacto knife and blades (or similar matt knife)
- Aluminum or steel ruler, 24 inches or longer +
- Artist box, or fishing tackle box
- Small water container (tin can or plastic bowl)
- Portfolio, 23x31 inches or larger (optional but strongly recommended for storing your work)
