



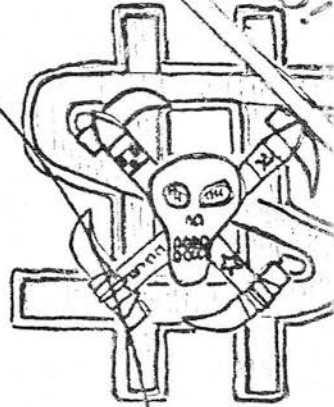

Anyway, we salute your daring. Enjoy!

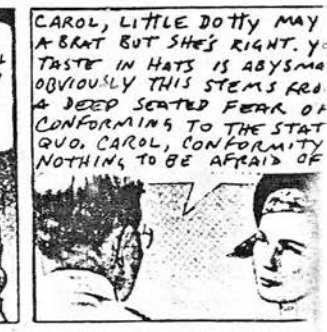

REAGAN'S FOLLY

Those of us who have a moral conscience should scope out president Reagan's foreign policy—which he seeks to establish as the policy of our generation. For it is we who shall suffer the consequences of its failure.

One keystone to his vision is his Strategic Defence Initiative, which consists of ground and space based anti missile missiles and lasers, and a variety of other measures designed to "eliminate the threat of nuclear annihilation" (along with a few pesky treaties) Rappin' Ronnie relies on public misconception to portray this as a worthy exercise.

One such misconception is the belief that SDI (commonly known as "Star Wars") will protect the PEOPLE of the United States. This is incorrect. Finally—Reagan assumes two things. One is that the Soviets are stupid enough to launch all of their missiles on "through-space" flight paths. We aren't the only ones who can build a cruise missile, Casper! The second and most important deception is that the Soviets can't be dealt with in rational "Earthly ways"—that to protect us from overwhelming technology and fear, we must resort to the same vices. Reagan disregards that the present state of affairs is NOT a result of a lack of strength, but of a lack of understanding. Let us not make the same mistake.

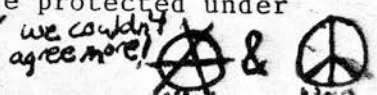
Is Reagan a friend of Corporate Fascists?
