The Department of Psychology at San José State University announces an Assistant Professor position in Clinical Psychology with a specialization in child- or gero-psychology to begin in August 2012. Applicants must have been awarded a Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology by August 2012, trained as a clinical scientist or scientist-practitioner and should be either a licensed psychologist or license eligible in California. Applicants should have awareness of and sensitivity to the educational goals of a multicultural population as might have been gained in cross-cultural study, training, teaching and other comparable experience.

Responsibilities:

San José State University is a teaching institution that values mentored research. The successful applicant should be prepared to take an active role in the Department's Masters of Arts in Experimental Psychology program as a clinical researcher serving on thesis committees. The successful candidate will be expected to teach undergraduate and/or graduate courses in abnormal and clinical psychology, child- or gero-psychology, writing, research methods, and introductory psychology as needed by the department. The successful candidate will also be expected to participate in department and university governance through membership in department, college, and university committees, and through academic advising of students. The successful candidate is expected to demonstrate an active program of research through publication and to maintain a productive research program, which may consist of collaborative research across the university as well as demonstrate an ability to form collaborative associations with community agencies or hospitals to continue their research program. The successful candidate must address the needs of a student population of great diversity – in age, cultural background, ethnicity, primary language and academic preparation – through course materials, teaching strategies and advisement.

Salary Range: Commensurate with qualifications and experience.
