Qualifications: Required: The candidate must have an earned doctorate or be in the process of finishing a doctorate in Educational Administration or related field. Potential for scholarly research and publications and successful grant writing commensurate with rank. Applicants will have demonstrated an ability to work successfully with diverse student and community populations. Applicants should have awareness of and sensitivity to the educational goals of a multicultural population as might have been gained in cross-cultural study, training, teaching and other comparable experience.

Preferred: Experience in K-12 school settings. Experience in developing and teaching graduate level courses in the following: school and/or district leadership in reform and change efforts and school/university collaborations, school finance and/or law, digital media in educational leadership.

Responsibilities: Teach courses in educational administration and leadership. Field supervision in educational settings. Chair and/or serve on masters' projects. Work collaboratively with members of educational community. Serve on department and university committees, and contribute to program and curriculum development. Candidate must address the needs of a student population of great diversity – in age, cultural background, ethnicity, primary language and academic preparation – through course materials, teaching strategies and advisement.
