**Brief Description of Duties:**

The School of Art and Design at San José State University is searching for part-time Animation/Illustration faculty members with expertise in any or all of the following subject areas for animation/illustration: drawing for animation foundation, visual and character development, story, painting and color for screen arts, 2D/3D animation, rigging, modeling, texturing, and lighting. Candidates should be actively engaged in Animation/Illustration or a closely related industry.

Candidates must exhibit knowledge of animation/illustration for film, television, and games within historical, socio-cultural, and technological perspectives. Part-time faculty will teach introductory, intermediate, and/or advanced traditional or digital courses within the context of the Animation/Illustration Program and the school as a whole.

**Minimum Qualifications:\***

Knowledge of the subject matter of the discipline to which the individual is assigned. Ability to relate well to others within the academic environment and ability to instruct and evaluate others. Evidence of satisfactory achievement in previous academic work. BA, BFA, BS, MA, MFA with professional experience. Previous teaching experience at the post-secondary level, which may include graduate teaching assistantships, is preferred. Applicants should demonstrate a record of professional activity along with their academic background.

**Salary Range:** \$2863 – 10,485 (*Full-Time Monthly Equivalent* ) Commensurate with qualifications and experience.  
(*Monthly pay will be based on appointment level for example a 0.20 appointment with FT Monthly Base of \$3000 would yield \$600 per month gross*)

**Eligibility:** Employment is contingent upon proof of eligibility to work in the United States.
