Part-Time Lecturer, Graphic Design

Qualifications:*

Knowledge of the subject matter of the discipline to which the individual is assigned. Ability to relate well to others within the academic environment and ability to instruct and evaluate others. Evidence of satisfactory achievement in previous academic work. BFA, an MFA, or MDES with previous teaching experience at the post-secondary level, which may include graduate teaching assistantships, is preferred. Applicants should demonstrate a record of professional design activity along with their academic background. Applicants should have awareness of and sensitivity to the educational goals of a multicultural population as might have been gained in cross-cultural study, training, teaching and other comparable experience.

Responsibilities / Brief Description of Duties:

The School of Art and Design at San José State University is searching for part-time graphic design faculty members with expertise in the following subject areas; image making, typography, visual exploration using electronic media with applications in the areas of "experience" and interactive design, data base visualization, three dimensional graphics, and time-based narratives. Candidates should be engaged in how words, images, motion, and sound work together to produce effective communication pieces through various media like print, and digital and network technology, with a special interest in the rhetorical thinking that lies behind the human-made world.

The candidate must exhibit knowledge of graphic design within historical, socio-cultural, and technological perspectives. Part-time faculty will teach introductory, intermediate, and/or advanced graphic design courses within the context of our design programs and the school as a whole.

Candidate must address the needs of a student population of great diversity – in age, cultural background, ethnicity, primary language and academic preparation – through course materials, teaching strategies and advisement.

Salary Range: \$2863 – 10,485 (*Full-Time Monthly Equivalent*) Commensurate with qualifications and experience.
(*Monthly pay will be based on appointment level for example a 0.20 appointment with FT Monthly Base of \$3000 would yield \$600 per month gross*)
