Qualifications: The Department of Design at San José State University invites applications for a Lecturer position in Interior Design. Applicants must possess a MFA degree in Interior Design, a Masters of Architecture (or closely related discipline) or a BFA in Interior Design or Bachelor of Architecture with over 8 years professional experience. NCIDA and LEED certification is required. Candidate must have strong and in-depth interior design industry experience in building codes and construction documents.

Candidate portfolio must demonstrate proficiency in:

- International Building Codes (IBC) as well as California code issues
- Revit Architecture 2011 Software
- Teaching space planning related to building codes preferred
- Teaching as-built drawings, construction documents, specifications, and FFE (furniture, fixtures, and equipment).

Applicants should have an awareness of and sensitivity to the educational goals of a multicultural population as might have been gained in cross-cultural study, training in teaching, and other comparable experiences.
