- If you have an issue with the heating system in your office, Submit a Work Order with Facilities Management to address the problem.
- If you need to use a space heater, consult with Facilities FIRST.
- Whether at home or at work, when using a space heater follow the following guidelines:





Choose a space heater that automatically shut off if the unit is knocked/tipped over, especially if you have pets or children.

Plug the space heater directly into a wall outlet. Do not use an extension cord. The heater's energy demand is too high and the extension cord can short circuit.





- Keep the unit at least 3 feet away from any combustible material such as papers.
- Place unit in a location where it is not touching any other objects.





- Use a space heater that is thermostatically controlled and shuts off when a certain temperature is reached.
- ► Turn off the unit when the area being heated is not occupied.

Keep unit in good working condition. Do not use if it has missing guards or controls.
