The Coordinator of the Paula Scholarship will work in conjunction with Spanish Section Scholarship Committee. All student applicants must fulfill the following:

- Be fully matriculated students majoring in Spanish at San José State University.
- Be upper division (senior standing) or graduate students in the year they receive the grant and have at least a 3.0 grade point average.
- Document their talent for and interest in Hispanic Studies by writing an essay in Spanish.
