

On March 16, 2017, the revised Executive Order entitled "[Protecting the Nation From Foreign Terrorist Entry Into the United States](#)" went into effect. Section 3 of this order suspends entry into the United States of foreign nationals from Iran, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria, and Yemen who were outside of the United States on March 16, 2017; did not have a valid visa at 5:00 p.m. EST on January 27, 2017; and who did not have a valid visa on March 16, 2017 for 90 days from the date the Executive Order was signed. Several exceptions apply to this entry suspension and are listed under Section 3(b).

We recommend that non-US citizens from the above-named countries who are currently in the U.S. on an immigrant or non-immigrant visa remain in the U.S. and cancel any planned travel abroad for the time being. It is not yet clear how this and other Executive Orders will actually be implemented.

For citizens of other countries, if you travel outside the U.S., you should expect increased visa delays and be aware of the risk that entry rules may change while you are traveling. Please speak with an [international student advisor](#) from the [International Student and Scholar Services \(ISSS\)](#) office should you need to renew your visa or have specific questions pertaining to your travel.

The College of International and Extended Studies and the ISSS office will continue to monitor this situation. Please watch for communications from our office and updates to our website and read through them carefully.
