Students are required to take 1 course each from Areas "R", "S", and "V" and the courses MUST BE from 3 different departments. You may have the option to use JS 116 (AREA "V" course beginning Spring 2010) to satisfy degree requirements and SJSU Studies Area "V" requirement, or you may use either JS 132 or JS 136 to satisfy degree requirements and SJSU Studies Area "S" requirement. You cannot use JS 116 (starting in Spring 2010) and JS 132/JS 136 to satisfy both SJSU Studies Areas "S" and "V".

General Education, PE and Additional Electives (60 units)

The purpose of these courses is to enhance your Justice Studies degree and to broaden your educational background. Please be sure to meet with a general education advisor in Student Services to make sure that you have completed all general education requirements. SJSU also requires that you have two different and distinct physical activities completed to graduate.

****A minimum of 120 units is required to earn the Justice Studies Degree. If you have completed all degree and University requirements and have less than 120 units, your degree will not be awarded. You will be required to take additional units to make-up for the difference.**
