**REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE NOMINATION OF MASTER'S THESIS COMMITTEES
(S87-6)**

A thesis committee shall be composed of no fewer than three members. The chairperson of the thesis committee shall hold a permanent (tenured or tenure track) San Jose State University faculty appointment and be on duty during the full academic year. Qualified individuals --including part-time temporary faculty, faculty on partial retirement, and non-faculty with expertise related to the thesis topic-- may serve as thesis committee members, but the majority of the thesis committee members shall hold San Jose State University faculty appointments.

JUSTICE STUDIES DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS

1. Master's Candidate must obtain agreement from each committee member prior to submitting the form.
2. Committee Chair must be tenured or tenure-track faculty in Justice Studies.
3. The Department recommends 3 committee members--two must be tenured or tenure-track faculty in Justice Studies.
4. In the case of larger committees, the majority of the committee must be tenured or tenure-track faculty in Justice Studies.
