

Kin 100W Outline Evaluation

Introduction

- 10% Title describes the topic.
- 10% Narrative hook is compelling.
- 10% Statement of research problem or question is appropriate to the topic.
- 10% Background section in summary states credible web sources used, or planned to be used related to topic.
- 10% Thesis or purpose statement relates dependent variable to independent variable.
- 10% Topic as reflected in thesis statement is relevant to kinesiology, complex enough to be interesting, focused enough to be written about in four pages, and is suitable for web research.

Body of Paper

- 10% In a logical manner, the topic sections describe the topic that was introduced in the introduction. There are three topic sections, with two to four sentences describing each one.

Discussion

- 10% Clearly written sentence describes matters that may be discussed that are logically related to the introduction and topic sections.

Summary and Conclusions

- 10% Summary sentence summarizes information presented in the topic and discussion sections. Conclusions are based on the topic and discussion sections, and are related to the thesis statement.

Organization, Grammar, and Sentence Structure

- 10% Outline reflects logical flow of paper: Topic is introduced. Three aspects of topic are discussed in the introduction. Thesis is relevant and clearly stated. Each aspect of the topic is discussed in the body of the paper. The discussion, summary, and conclusion flow logically from the introduction, thesis, and body of paper. Outline is written in complete sentences. Grammar and punctuation are correct.
