

MBA Course Registration: New Policy for Students from Other Graduate Programs

Due to the large number of students currently enrolled in the On-Campus MBA Program, we are no longer permitting students from other graduate programs to register in the required/core MBA courses during the Advanced Registration period beginning with the Fall 2008 semester. Students from other graduate programs may add MBA required/core courses to their schedule during the Late Registration Period (which begins the first day of instruction) with a permission number given by the instructor. Instructors are not obligated to add students from other programs to their class, as the current catalog now states as a prerequisite that the class is restricted to MBA students only.

These constraints do not apply to elective classes at this time, only the core classes which are:

If the class is full and the instructor is willing to add additional students, they are asked to please add MBA students prior to students from other programs.
