

**SJSU Lucas Graduate School of Business
M.S. Taxation
Special Session Open University Information**

Taking classes in the M.S. Taxation (MST) program through Open University is for those students who have not been formally admitted to the M.S. Taxation program. Students who already have an MST (from SJSU or elsewhere) also must use this procedure to register for MST courses. In order to take MST classes, you must: (1) have an undergraduate degree, (2) have completed an intermediate accounting and an introductory tax course, and (3) have satisfied the appropriate prerequisites for the class you wish to take. **You may not take classes in the M.S. Taxation program through Open University if you have previously been denied admission.**

Please note the following:

- **If you have a degree in M.S. Taxation** from San Jose State University, or elsewhere, you may take an unlimited number of M.S. Taxation courses through Open University.
- **If you do not have a degree in M.S. Taxation** you may only take a maximum of two courses (6 units) through Open University. After completing 6 units, you must apply for the program, and be formally admitted, in order to continue taking courses. We only admit students twice a year: in the Fall semester, which begins in September and in the Spring semester, which begins in January. Please be aware of application deadlines:

Note: SJSU Open University courses are considered the equivalent to “transfer” units. Enrolled students may transfer up to 6 semester units from either SJSU Open University or another institution to apply towards their SJSU MST graduation requirement. Courses from other universities must be approved by the Program Director in order to count toward your SJSU MST degree. Thus, if you plan to transfer in a 3-unit graduate level tax class from another university, while you may still take up to 6 units of Open University at SJSU before enrolling in the MST program, only 6 of the 9 units can be applied toward your degree. All courses, including those taken through Open University, expire in 7 years. Grades in classes taken at SJSU through Open University will be counted as part of your Graduate record if/when you are admitted to SJSU.

Registration Instructions:

1. Visit <http://www.sjsu.edu/lucasschool/current/mst/schedule/> to view the upcoming schedule. Please be aware of prerequisites. If you have any question as to whether you are ready for a particular class, you should contact the MST Program Director.
2. Complete the attached form (separate form for each class) and bring it with you to the first class meeting. If the instructor permits you to add the class, he or she will sign and collect the form. There is NO PRE-REGISTRATION. You must attend the first day.
3. All forms will be screened by the Lucas Graduate School of Business to assure compliance with the above criteria and forwarded to the Registrar’s Office.
4. You will be notified by email when you are registered in the course and given your SJSU ID number, as well as the due date for your fees.
5. Pay your fees. Fees are \$1,485 per class. See reverse side for payment methods. Please be sure to view the drop/refund schedule. There is a link to this from the schedule page.
6. If you have any questions, please contact the Program Coordinator.

Admitted students in the MST program will be given first priority for registration and are permitted to pre-register. It is University policy to add Open University students on a "space available" basis, and it is at the discretion of the instructor whether to add an Open University student. If there are more students wanting to sign up on the first class day than there are seats, the instructor will use a random drawing process to select the students who will be added to the class. If a class becomes full prior to the first day of instruction with

admitted students, we will note this on the schedule page of the website (<http://www.sjsu.edu/lucasschool/current/mst/schedule/>). Please be sure to check the website prior to attending the first day to make sure the class is not already full. While there is no guarantee until the first night of class that enough space will be available, and that you will be added into the class, the MST program runs on a compressed schedule and you will not want to be behind if you are permitted to add. Therefore, you should check the syllabus online <http://www.sjsu.edu/lucasschool/current/mst/schedule/> and may want to either buy the book or find some other means to do the first week's reading.

Methods of Payment

All payments are handled by the Bursar's Office in the Student Services Center (www.sjsu.edu/bursar). Payments must be submitted by the due date. Submitting this form means you will be enrolled in the class (if eligible) and there is no automatic drop for non-payment of fees. Therefore, once you submit this form, you are obligated to pay the fees.

In order to pay your fees, you have a choice of the following methods:

1. **Check:** Checks should be made payable to SJSU. Your student ID must appear on the face of the check. Please mail it to: SJSU Bursar's Office, One Washington Square, San Jose, CA 95192-0138. It may also be dropped off in person at the Bursar's office, or in the Bursar's Drop Box. Checks must be **received** by the deadline.
 - You may also bring a check the first day of class and submit it to the instructor along with your form. After the first day, you must mail checks directly to the Bursar's Office. If you are submitting a check on the first day, the SJSU ID will be filled in for you after you are officially registered in the course.
2. **Cash:** in person at Bursar's office.
3. **Debit card:** in person at Bursar's office.
4. **Credit Card:** Pay online with PayPath Payment Service at <http://ou.sjsu.edu/>. From here click on "[PayPath Payment Service](#)." This service allows you to make credit card payment for San José State University student accounts. Students will be asked to provide their date of birth, SJSU ID number and the term. A non-refundable PayPath service fee of 2.75 % (minimum of \$3.00) will be added to your payment. PayPath accepts Mastercard, American Express and Discover only.

If you need to pay by some other means, i.e. your company is paying for the class, please contact the Bursar's office on how to proceed. Their information is here: <http://www.sjsu.edu/bursar/>

Dropping/Refund

If you would like to drop a class, please contact the Program Coordinator for the appropriate form. Approval to drop is not guaranteed.

Note: Once you are enrolled, you are obligated to pay the fee. You may petition for a refund, but it is not guaranteed. This holds true whether or not you attend the class and regardless of whether or not you have paid your fee. (i.e., if you just decide to not pay the fee and do not drop, a balance will remain on your account).
