**SJSU Admission:**

SJSU has a 3 semester RN to BSN program. Currently, students are admitted to the university every Fall and start courses in Fall and Spring. Program admission is contingent upon meeting minimum SJSU admission requirements and passing a drug screen and background check. The following pre-requisites courses are required for admission to the program :

- Oral Communication/Speech
- Critical Thinking/Logic
- Statistics
- Chemistry

**RN to BSN Admission:** The nursing applications for the RN to BSN program are due October 1st for Spring admission and February 1st for Fall admission. It is strongly recommended that RNs attend an on campus/ web conference RN to BSN advising session. These sessions are held throughout the Fall and Spring semesters. Dates/times for each RN to BSN advising sessions are posted on the School of Nursing website <http://www.sjsu.edu/nursing/students/advising/index.html>

**How do I apply?**

**Step 1:** Attend an advising session (strongly encouraged)

**Step 2:** Apply for admission to SJSU - <http://www.csumentor.edu> by the Fall deadline of the year before you plan to attend

**Step 3:** Apply for admission to the RN to BSN program - <http://www.nursingcas.org/> by October 1st for Spring entry and February 1st for Fall Entry

**RNs accepted to the RN to BSN program must have:**

- A current unrestricted license as a Registered Nurse in California
- Completed at least 60 semester units of baccalaureate-level transferable college units. RNs may transfer up to 70 units to SJSU.
- Completed an AD or Diploma in nursing with a minimum of 30 semester units of nursing coursework with a grade of **C** or better in each course
- Completed nursing pre-requisites of Critical Thinking, Oral Communication, Chemistry and Statistics with a grade of **C** or better
- Gained admission to SJSU as a RN to BSN major
- Meet drug screening and background check requirements.
- Prior to the program start date students must provide proof of up to date immunizations as outlined by the School of Nursing (specifics are provided to admitted applicants, along with a deadline date for completion).
