II. Citation/listing styles

A. Two major citation styles (journal specific)

1. By number

2. By author

B. Number

1. Citation either in parentheses (at some point before".") or superscript (usually after".")

2. Listing in ascending order

3. Ex.: Guharoy & Chakrabarti (2005), remember MajorLec. 1 link

C. Author

1. Citation (last name(s) and date)

2. Listing alphabetically

3. Ex.: Panchenko et al. (2004)

III. More on citation and listing

A. Journal specific

1. Example: Dimitrov & Zuker (2004)

a. NOTE Dimitrov & Zuker (2004) in html ref. listings, where mixing of numbers w/ alphabetized refs. cited by author, would generally be a no-no!!

B. Include title for Review Paper reference listings

C. Books, including monographs

D. Other formats, like reports as well as thesis and unpublished material

E. Online materials

F. Other

1. For abbreviation format (link), remember to FIX capitalizations and insert periods.
