A. See handout

B. Title different than one for Primary Ref., Minor Paper or Research Review

III. Mechanics of giving a 10 min. talk (with added 2 mins. of questions)

A. About 8-10 slides

1. Title Slide (for Oral Present. you will want to include title of your talk, your name, affiliation, the date and Primary Ref.)

a. Here title is not the same as the actual research article

2. Next slide(s) is/are an “Overview”

a. “Straight-forward” (e.g. Introduction; Methods; Results & Discussion; Conclusions (assumes no just Discussion slide)

OR b. “Implicit” (laying out in order the key ideas)

3. Core slides

a. Matching one type of roadmap noted above: Introduction; Methods; Results & Discussion (or Results; Discussion)

OR b. Organize by intellectual order

c. Discuss Core slides in connected way

i. Before at least first data slide (e.g. x-y plot) have a text or schematic slide that sets up data

4. Also Conclusions slide

a. Can include separate General and Future Studies sub-sections)

B. Have thumbnail or outline as notes

1. Each major point should correspond to a slide

2. Do not read aloud from notes

3. If you wish a pointer, you must provide it

4. If wish to have remote “clicker”, check native (e.g. remote) DH503 LCD Projector setup or your own USB-based device on a PREVIOUS day
