

## **L. P. Social Work Fellowship Award, 2011-2012**

The L. P. Social Work Fellowship Award will be granted to a Master's level student in their final year of the MSW program who demonstrates excellence in academics and abilities to assist MSW students in writing skills, especially students who speak languages other than English. The Fellowship will include up to \$2,375 for the 2011-2012 academic year.

### **Selection Criteria and Application Process**

#### **Required Characteristics:**

- 1) A Master's level student currently in their final year of the MSW program
- 2) A student in good academic standing with a GPA of 3.0 or better

Three items are needed to apply for this Fellowship:

- 1) **A one-page letter, double-spaced**, that describes your experiences in the following areas: 1) Working with students who speak languages other than English; 2) Previous teaching or tutoring experience, especially in writing; 3) Computer and technology skills and 4) Interpersonal skills
- 2) **Your final, graded SW 242 research proposal paper.**
- 3) **A current resume**, that includes one reference from a faculty member in the School of Social Work. A letter from the faculty member is **not required**.

Please submit these materials in hard copy form to Ed Cohen, MSW Program Coordinator by **Friday, November 18, 2011**. Personal interviews of qualified applicants by a faculty committee will take place the week of November 21.

**General duties of the fellowship winner may include:** 1) Individual assessment and tutorials with approximately 10 to 15 MSW students; and 2) Planning and implementing group tutorials. The expected start of these activities is the week of November 28.
