**Please see the assignment description, format and examples, which are posted separately.**

In your paper, be sure to assess the importance and significance of the example you are documenting. If you are documenting an example already in the archive, please examine that contribution in the archive and only include in your paper ideas and documentation not already provided. You are welcome to reassess or update already collected archival material.

Examples of the relations between these peoples, may include individual relations or relations between neighbors, communities, or governments. Please include copies of whatever supporting materials you are able to include, as well as a full bibliography and list of other sources at the end of your paper.

There is no specific page requirement for this assignment. Grading will be based upon thoroughness and clarity of research, documentation of significance, and quality of supporting materials. Use of primary oral and written sources are valued above secondary sources and internet downloads. Please assess the reliability of your sources. Remember, you will be presenting your research to the class.

Submit all materials together in a folder or envelope labeled with your name, class, semester, and year. One copy will be for archival purposes, the other will be returned to you with comments.

Please use the following title page for the second copy of your paper & supporting materials

1. \_\_\_\_\_ *FORM:* Papers should be neat, clearly written, and comprehensible. Please proof read for spelling, grammatical, and syntactic problems. One point is taken off for each writing error. Do NOT use plastic folders please.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ *PROBLEM/  
CONTENT:* Please be sure that you are addressing the questions at hand. Be concise and to the point. Please do not simply describe an organization, website or material taken from books and other sources, evaluate them. Be sure you are making a point, not filling space.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ *ANALYSIS:* All papers must have an analytical component. Your criteria and evaluation should be clearly presented, with supporting evidence and, if appropriate, include arguments which could be used to refute your analysis. Make sure that there is depth to your analysis.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ *CONCLUSION:* The generalizations you make in your concluding remarks should address the “SO WHAT” question. Why is important about the example you are presenting here? Why should anyone care, and what do you care about here? What have you learned as a result of your evaluation that you might not have thought about otherwise?
5. \_\_\_\_\_ *SOURCES:* Your paper should be based upon sources beyond your own belief, opinion or the opinion of a single author or individual. Be sure to have considered more than one perspective. Sources should be clearly listed within the body of your paper using internal citations (not footnotes). List all bibliographic references at the end of your paper.
6. \_\_\_\_\_ *LATE:* See Course Guidelines for number of points deducted for late papers.
