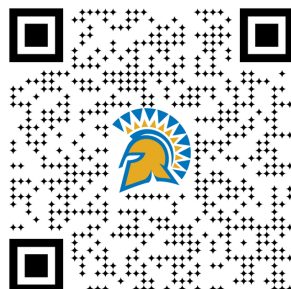

## Requirements

- US 4-year Bachelor's degree or equivalent, including biology, molecular biology, physiology, engineering, psychology, public health, zoology, chemistry and others.
- GPA of 2.5 or higher in the last two years of university coursework in the last 60 semester units of study.
- General GRE-writing 4.0 (lower scores can be reviewed by the Directors).
- Statement of purpose, resume and two letters of recommendation.
- TOEFL iBT 100 or IELTS 8.0 or Duolingo 120 (for international students).
