<a href="#"><u>Emeritus and Retired Faculty Association RSCA Award (ERFA)</u></a>	Lecturers with more than 6 years of continuous service to SJSU, tenure-track faculty and tenured faculty	Two awards up to \$2,500	December	July 1 – June 30
<a href="#"><u>Faculty Diversity Development Research, Curricular and Creative Activities</u></a>	Lecturers, tenure-track and tenured faculty	0.2 RT, or \$5,000 salary awards, or \$5,000 research funds	Typically late Fall semester of the academic year	July 1 - June 30
<a href="#"><u>University Grants Academy (UGA)</u></a>	Tenure-track and tenured faculty who have not yet received major external grants	0.2 assigned time for T/TT faculty and the resources covering the supporting tools at the disposition of the T/TT faculty during the UGA program	Typically late Fall semester of the academic year	Spring Semester
<a href="#"><u>The Weir/Galm Award Program</u></a>	Tenure-track faculty	\$2,500	September	November 1 – March 15

<a href="#"><u>Explorations in Research, Scholarship and Creative Activity (ExRSCA)</u></a>	Undergraduate Students currently enrolled with a faculty advisor	\$1,000 faculty professional development award	Typically late Fall semester of the academic year	July 1 – June 30
<a href="#"><u>CSU Program for Education &amp; Research in Biotechnology (CSUPERB)</u></a>	Students and Faculty dependent on grant type	\$1,000 to \$15,000 (depending on grant type)	Varies by grant type	Varies by grant type
<a href="#"><u>CSU Council on Ocean Affairs, Science &amp; Technology (COAST)</u></a>	Students and Faculty dependent on grant type	Varies by grant type	Varies by grant type	Varies by grant type
<a href="#"><u>Water Resources and Policy Initiatives (WRPI)</u></a>	Faculty and/or CSU Students from an underrepresented group	Faculty: 0.2 RT up to 4 semesters Students: Up to \$20,000 (doctoral scholarship)	Faculty: Typically May of each academic year Students: Typically June of each academic year	Faculty: Fall 2017-Spring 2018 Students: 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 academic years (\$10,000 each year)

# Central Research, Scholarship and Creative Activity (RSCA) Program

<b>Funding Description</b>	Provides support to faculty for their research, scholarship, and creative activities
<b>Max Award</b>	\$5,000 or 0.2 RT, or one-month summer salary (capped at \$5,000)
<b>Spending Period</b>	July 1 – June 30
<b>Eligibility</b>	<a href="#">Unit 3 faculty</a>
<b>Applications Due</b>	March of each academic year
