Policy Statement from the MS Clinical Program at SJSU

RE: Students seeking courses but not admission in the MS program:

Students or professionals who have obtained a degree from another graduate program and who wish to take a course in the MS program but who do not want to be enrolled in the degree program (e.g., a course needs to be taken for California licensing requirements) may apply to do so on an individual student and individual course basis.

Clinical contact courses cannot be taken when not admitted to and enrolled in the MS program (e.g., gaining therapy hours or courses in practicum, fieldwork, clinic, or other supervision experience).

In order to take a course in the MS program, students will be required to:

- (1) provide a letter of good standing from their home university,
- (2) provide a letter of reference about the student or professional,
- (3) provide a copy of their transcript from their graduate training,
- (4) meet with the instructor of the course(s) he or she wishes to take to get approval from that instructor, and
- (5) obtain approval from the clinical committee provided points 1-4 have been met.
