Policy Statement from the MS Clinical Program at SJSU

RE: Transferring students/courses from other graduate programs in clinical psychology

Students who wish to be admitted into our program after having taken courses at other universities may apply for admission to our program for the following Fall Semester like any other student seeking admission.

We have a specific policy about accepting transferred course units into the MS program. Generally we **do not** accept graduate courses transferred from another **graduate** program taken at another university. However, on a case-by-case basis, individual courses will be reviewed by the appropriate faculty members and the Clinical Committee to determine if those courses may be transferred into our program.

Consistent with other graduate programs and the policy of the university, we allow up to two courses maximally to be transferred. Clinical contact courses are not transferable (e.g., courses in practicum, fieldwork, clinic, clinical assessment). Non-clinical contact courses that are transferred do not have to be re-taken.
