Four Year Planner for Incoming Freshman Psychology Majors who desire to pursue the more research oriented Bachelor of Science degree rather than the Bachelor of Arts degree.

Core GE generally requires 39 units. You also need to take American Institutions (Areas F1-3). We recommend but do not require covering F1-3 with Area D2/3 coursework. Several courses (Psyc 1, Stat 95 and Bio 21) cover both GE course and major requirements, but the units only count one time. You need 120 units to graduate. Pre-med students should seek out the premed advisor from the Biology Department. A minor is not required.

** Stat 95 is a prerequisite to Psyc 100W. Psyc 100W is required (no WST waiver) and is a prerequisite to Psyc 120 and 190.
