**Color of the Sea/WWII Campus Tour**

The SJSU campus was involved and connected to WWII in several ways. Over 4,000 students, alums and employees served, anti-aircraft artillery was placed on the campus, and the football team was in Hawaii when Pearl Harbor was bombed. This campus tour visits campus locations with a WWII connection and includes a visit to the university's Special Collection in the King Library to see various artifacts from that time period. Tour begins outside between the Smith-Carlos statue and Clark Hall.
