Reflectiveness

Indicators:

- Practices critical questioning
- Is responsive to criticism
- Is responsive to opposing views
- Articulates opposing views
- Examines personal strengths and weaknesses
- Questions own beliefs and practices
- Exhibits flexibility

Responsibility

Indicators:

- Constructively responds to obligations
- Oral and written agreements with others
- Coursework/Assignments
- Timeliness
- Engages actively in program experiences

Commitment to Professionalism

Indicators:

- Demonstrates an understanding of the legal obligations of teaching
- Demonstrates ongoing commitment to professional development
- Practices collaboration and collegiality to reach identified goals

Commitment to Fairmindedness and Equity

Indicators:

- Treats others with equal respect, courtesy, and dignity
- Is intolerant of all forms of harassment, discrimination, and exploitation
- Recognizes the need for differences to ensure equal treatment of all
