**SENSE OF THE SENATE RESOLUTION
PROTECTION OF CAMPUS TREES**

- Whereas,** the Campus Planning Board is responsible for enhancement and maintenance of plant and animal life on the SJSU campus, and
- Whereas,** the Board is charged to consider both the aesthetic and instructional value of campus plantings, and
- Whereas,** some recent landscaping and grading activity on campus resulted in the removal of trees without prior consultation with the Board, now, therefore, be it
- Resolved,** that the Academic Senate SJSU respectfully requests all university administrators to cooperate with the Campus Planning Board in its protection of plant and animal life on the campus and to consult with the Board before taking action which might have an adverse effect on our physical environment.
