- Proposal to revise History major structure: m/s/p, unanimously.
- Environmental Studies 10, Life on a Changing Planet: m/s/p, unanimously for proposal and GE status with changes to be worked out with Assoc. Dean. Changes to include: 1. correct O'Malley's Ph.D. field to Biology; 2. change to C-2; 3. more emphasis on science in the greensheet; 4. see if Biology will provide letter of support; 5. see if community colleges have similar course for GE credit.
 - Anthropology 157, Forensic Anthropology: m/s/p, unanimously.
- Discussed mode and level (C-factor) issues and importance of updating this information in course inventories.

Discussed what should go in the bibliography that accompanies course proposals. Full consensus was not reached but there appeared to be agreement that about one page with complete citations was appropriate. In general, the materials should provide more scholarly and in-depth presentation of components of the course content.
