 You should consult with an advisor in your major department to select the best sequence of major courses, especially in your junior and senior years.
- Several courses (such as Soci 1) fulfill major and Core GE requirements, but the units count only once toward the 120 units required for graduation.
 You may count only one SJSU studies course for credit in the major, although you may take other sociology SJSU studies courses and count them toward the major.
- You may need only two courses to cover the American Institutions area (F1, F2, & F3), and to count for Core GE.
- Note that the semester units do not add up to 120 units since some classes may count toward GE and major/minor requirements.
- A minor is strongly recommended, but not required, for the degree.
