



Things to remember for Level II Admission

Qualifications to be considered for the program admission:

- ____ 1. Complete application forms and bring complete packet to Department office
- ____ 2. Apply online to Graduate School immediately
- ____ 3. Include Copy of California Preliminary (Level I) Education Specialist Credential
- ____ 4. Provide proof of employment (Complete form CL 777.1)
- ____ 5. Complete Candidate's self-assessment form (attached to application packet)
- ____ 6. Include an essay as to what you expect from advanced professional development (new Level II students only)
- ____ 7. Include resume (new students only)
- ____ 8. Secure three recommendation/reference forms (new students only)
- ____ 9. Complete the upper part of the Professional Dispositions Evaluation form (new students)

Qualifications to continue in the program after admission:

- Meet with or contact you assigned advisor regularly.
- Have completed Self-Assessment Forms
- Have developed a Professional Induction Plan (PIP)
- Have developed a Program Planning Guide (contract)
- Maintain a GPA of 3.0 or better with all grades of B or better
- Take required courses and practicum as a matriculated student
- Completed Electives

Qualifications to complete and exit program:

- Passed Directed Teaching II (DHH 234, ECSE 234, M/M 217B, M/S 105)
- Completed and Submitted Professional Portfolio or BTSA Portfolio
- Have completed second part of Dispositions Self-Evaluation Form (retrieve from your file if you completed Level I at SJSU).
- Complete PIP
- Complete Exit Interview with Level II Directed Teaching Supervisor
- Completed 2 years work experience in regular special education teaching position after receiving Level I credential (Position must match credential)
- Finalized contract (Program Planning Guide): This form must be signed by your advisor, the program coordinator and the department chair
- Submitted program evaluation
