A significant business tax increase of the TCJA is imposed on the foreign income of U.S. shareholders of foreign companies. Form 5471, with its longstanding \$10,000 penalty, is now a tax return where this tax is reflected. If your company or clients operate internationally, this class is critical to help you understand and successfully address the changes to the 2018 Form 5471 and its schedules, and to be aware of planning considerations.
