3. Maintain automobile insurance while enrolled in internship in the MSW Program.
4. Attend all child welfare trainings and seminars, and meet the Title IV-E Child Welfare Curriculum Competencies.
5. Obligation to pay back this award is on a year-to-year basis. A full-time student has at least two-year employment commitment in a public child welfare agency.
