Characteristics of a Good Research Question

Interesting

Does the research question interest you?

Relevant

Is the question relevant to the field of urban and regional planning?

Specific

Is the question specific enough or is too vague and broad? Can you generate a clear hypothesis?

Feasible

Is it possible to answer the research question in the given time and resources? More specifically:

- Do you know what research methods might be needed to answer the question?
- Do you have mastery over those methods?
- Given your time and budget, do you have access to the data or other information you need,?
