Version 3.0 of the University Web Template kit was launched in November, 2007 to include accessible templates. The template kit contains six new page layout options, allowing webmasters and content editors flexibility in creating content while retaining the SJSU look and feel.

WebCMS version 7.0 (WebCMS 7) was launched in February, 2008. WebCMS 7 leverages the university Web templates and provides a framework for content editors to create accessible Web pages. Currently administrative websites and websites for campus wide initiative are encouraged to use WebCMS 7.
